

Rules for seminar papers / academic performances as examination prerequisites as of Examination Regulations Mechanical Engineering Bachelor v3b

Rules for the semester

- The successful completion of a seminar paper / academic performance is required for the registration of exams in
 - Technical Presentation (as of PO v4)
 - Machine Elements – Principles (as of PO v4)
 - Machine Elements – Connections (as of PO v3b)
 - Machine Elements – Drive Engineering (as of PO v3b)
- Proof of passing a seminar paper / academic performance is provided upon having passed the number of design assignments set in the examination regulation (each consisting of 5-10 submitted DIN A4 pages). The result is published in PAUL ("be" (P), "nb" (NP)). The note about successful completion is valid indefinitely.

Rules for the refresher semester

- If proof of having passed the seminar paper / academic performance was not provided (evaluation in PAUL "nb" (NP)) the seminar paper / academic performance can be repeated in a refresher semester. A semester in which the respective course is not offered is considered a refresher semester. This also applies to students not bound by the examination regulations Mechanical Engineering Bachelor v3b.
- To repeat a seminar paper / academic performance, students have to register in PAUL for the respective exam at the beginning of the refresher semester during the initial exam registration period.
- After the initial exam registration period, there will be an opening event presenting the support team and explaining the organization. The date for this event will be communicated by e-mail.
- The organization is currently carried out in PANDA.

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
